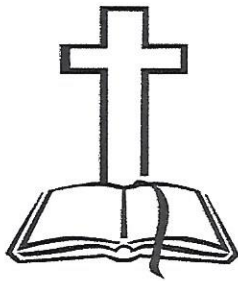
All this is to have succeeded.
