As a response to that, this gentleman has made it his life's mission to share the Gospel with members of the deaf community wherever he has gone.

So this got me to asking the question, "Who are the unreached, under-reached, ignored people of our community?" What are we as the assembly of God's people in Leachville intentionally doing to reach them? Is it enough that they drive by our building and see our sign by the street? Is it enough that we are active on Facebook? Is it enough that we have an After School Special program 12 Wednesday's during the school year? I really don't think it is. We need to be actively finding ways to directly share the Gospel message with all who need to hear it!


