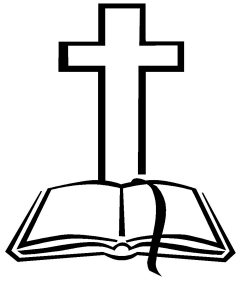
We need to be the same as the church of Christ. We should be willing to forgive and to give mercy to anyone, even if they don't deserve it.
