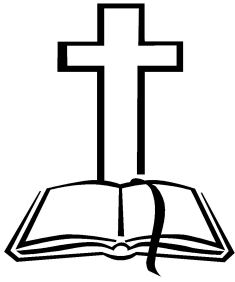
There is a God, and He is alive. Believe in and follow after Him.
