As these bad things have been happening to him, he writes Psalm 34.

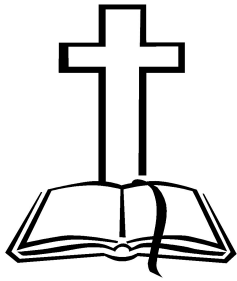
