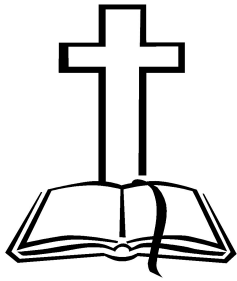
Jeremiah 5:11, “For the house of Israel and the house of Judah have dealt very treacherously with Me,” declares the Lord.
