

## The Good Shepherd – Part 3

After the resurrection of Jesus, He appears to His disciples and Apostles. Just prior to His death, Jesus told Peter that he would deny his Leader three times. In contrast to that event, we read this discussion between Jesus and Peter in **John 21:15-17**.

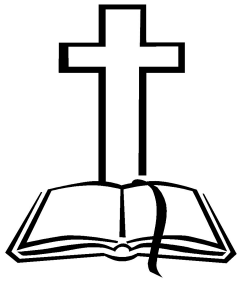
*“15 When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?” He said to him, “Yes, Lord; you know that I love you.” He said to him, “Feed my lambs.” 16 He said to him a second time, “Simon, son of John, do you love me?” He said to him, “Yes, Lord; you know that I love you.” He said to him, “Tend my sheep.” 17 He said to him the third time, “Simon, son of John, do you love me?” Peter was grieved because he said to him the third time, “Do you love me?” and he said to him, “Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you.” Jesus said to him, “Feed my sheep.*

Jesus, “The Good Shepherd” (John 10:11), is back to have one more conversation with one of His closest friends and apprentices and he tells him to feed His sheep. I don’t know about you, but that communicates to me that Jesus’s primary purpose as shepherd was to provide his sheep with nourishment. Let me encourage you to think on that this week.
