What the shepherd failed to realize is that when he moved his sheep, he took them to a place where there was little to eat. He moved them to a place of safety, of comfort, but he was starving his sheep.

As David writes **Psalm 23**, he says of God, "1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. 3 He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake."

When we think of what we need from God, our minds my take us to a place of health, financial means, wisdom, etc. We tend to lean toward thinking of God as a provider of comfort, but what the Psalmist alludes to is that God is more than that. God is a provider of nourishment and life.

Let us praise God today that He is exactly the shepherd that we need!
