

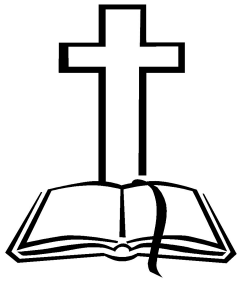
Ten Commandments of Human Relationships
