*It is, moreover, especially our duty to offer our humble prayers to the Father of All Mercies for a continuance of His divine favor to us as a nation and as individuals.*

In the year that these words were penned, the United States was celebrating its centennial. In his proclamation, President Grant acknowledged that for one century, the country was able to fulfill its purpose.

The Leachville church of Christ will celebrate its 100th year in 2018. What an exciting year of celebration can look forward to! We will look back on our past and consider the great people and works that have been a part of this church. 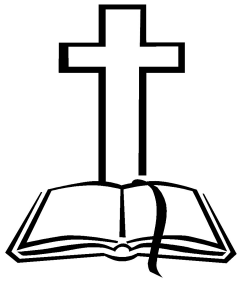


